(Philadelphia, PA) Red Square Theatre, the company that premiered *Clover* at the 2009 Philly Fringe, presents the world premiere of *The Swedish Match*. This original stage adaptation brings to life one of Anton Chekhov's early short stories. The style and humor in *The Swedish Match* are a rare look into Chekhov's flare for comedy and the beginnings of the detective parody genre.

Follow a pair of bumbling, small town detectives as they investigate a mysterious murder. Sit back and savor the madness as the two men weed their way through wild theories, crazy clues and a ridiculous pack of suspects. You'll meet a drunken butler, oversexed housewives, and one dimwitted shepherd as you enjoy a laugh-filled evening with *The Swedish Match!* 

This play grew out of Red Square Theatre's desire to honor the **150th Anniversary** of Anton Chekhov's birth by bringing to the stage one of his funniest short stories. Although more widely recognized for his plays, Chekhov was also a doctor and prolific writer, having penned hundreds of short stories in his lifetime. His written works are held in high esteem by literary and theatre critics alike and he is considered by many to be the father of the modern play.

As with many artists, Chekhov held a second job to support his artistic endeavors: "Medicine is my lawful wife", he is quoted as saying, "and literature is my mistress." Red Square Theatre knows firsthand the marriage between economy and the arts as five of its founding company members moved to Philadelphia from Detroit, MI in search of both jobs and artistic opportunities. What they discovered was an abundance of both and they hope to continue contributing to the theatrical landscape of Philadelphia for many years.
